Production & Pet Stock

Department of Poultry, Rabbits, and Pet stock open to bonafide breeders.

1. Entries in any exhibit in this division coming in later than the time set for judging to begin will not be allowed to compete.
2. Judging will begin at 9:00am.
3. Exhibits will be released at 5:00pm on the closing day of the fair.
4. All birds must be entered in the name of the bonafide owner. He or she must also be the owner of the variety or varieties entered. When the management is satisfied that this rule has been violated, the person making the false entry will be barred from receiving prize money awarded each entry or entries.
5. Every effort will be made to keep the poultry building in a sanitary condition; and every precaution will be taken against loss by fire, disease or theft, but the Society will not be held responsible for loss of stock on the grounds.
6. Birds showing symptoms of disease will not be permitted to remain on the grounds.
7. Placing of awards: The Stalwart Fair Society believes that egg production should be a very important factor in the judging of poultry. We have; therefore, decided to have all awards placed on the utility basis. The latest revised standard of perfection will be the guide in determining disqualification. The approved systems of judging for production will be that approved by Michigan State University Poultry Department.
8. All entries over four (4) will be charged \$.25 (quarter) with the exception of goats which is a \$1.00.
